### **Replacement Batteries.**

Replacement Batteries are available at most libraries (see the [full list of participating libraries](#)) for a full list see and many health centres, but not from your GP. If you are unable to collect batteries yourself, you can send someone in your place with your yellow battery book.

If none of the above is possible, you can also send your yellow battery book to the address below.
