PRESCRIBING ALLERGY FORMULA MILKS

Extensively hydrolysed formula (EHF)

EHF is the first line treatment for mild to moderate CMPA and tolerated by 90% of infants with CMPA. For dairy free trial please prescribe 8 x 400g tins.

Amino acid formula (AAF)

Amino acid formula should only be prescribed in primary care if an infant presents with severe allergic symptoms to cow's milk. Otherwise AAF should be initiated on advice from secondary care or specialist dietitian.

Both EHF and AA formulas have an unpleasant taste and smell. In order to promote acceptance of the formula please advise a gradual introduction of these by mixing together with usual formula over a 5 day period until fully on to EHF/AA formula.
