


PROLONGED JAUNDICE Please use in conjunction with the Prolonged Jaundice Guideline on Badgernet

RED FLAGS:

 Pale or 'suspect' stools at any time

- Family history of recurrent jaundice or blood disorder or whose parents are consanguineous
- Has been formula feeding exclusively without and breast milk received in the last 7 days
- Has not regained birth weight by 14 days and where there is evidence that weight gain is not reassuring; or, where weight gain has become poor since regaining birth weight
- Has had previous NNU admission for intensive phototherapy due to suspected haemolysis

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
