

## Imaging – Testes

<b>Ultrasound Indicated:</b>	<b>Ultrasound Not Indicated Routinely:</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Intra-testicular lump or uncertainty about whether a lump is intra- or extra-testicular.</li><li>• Impalpable testis with hydrocoele of recent origin.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Extra-testicular lump with normal testis</li><li>• Subcutaneous lumps/ pinhead sized nodules – these are common and are not testicular cancers.</li><li>• Testicular/epididymal pain and normal examination – not first line investigation, but ultrasound may be appropriate to exclude malignancy with persistent testicular pain.</li><li>• Suspected torsion – requires urgent referral.</li></ul>
