

## Imaging – Knee

<b>X-Ray Indicated:</b>	<b>X-Ray Not Indicated Routinely:</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Knee pain with locking, restricted movement or effusion</li><li>• Knee pain when surgery considered</li><li>• Trauma with physical signs</li><li>• Suspected malignancy in patient with knee pain</li><li>• Clinical diagnosis of OA and no previous X-Ray (symptoms &gt;6 weeks and &lt;1 year and patient willing to undergo surgery)</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Knee pain without locking or restricted movement</li><li>• ? Osgood Schlatter's disease</li><li>• ? OA (unless surgery considered)</li><li>• Trauma when physical signs are minimal</li><li>• ? Baker's cyst - neither is ultrasound referral indicated to confirm the diagnosis</li></ul>

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
