New Cancer Era: Immunotherapy for Primary Care



Overview

Recent years has seen significant changes in the way that cancer is treated. The development of checkpoint inhibitors (Immunotherapy) has drastically changed the outlook for some cancers, notably melanoma, renal and lung cancer. These drugs have a differing side effect profile compared to standard chemotherapy and have the potential for late effects, even years after they have stopped.
