Homemade hypertonic saline nose drops for children with the common cold: ELVIS Kids results

ELVIS Kids study, is a randomised controlled study done across Scotland where parents made and applied salt water nose drops for their kids when they had a common cold. The results will be presented, science behind it will be explained, and briefly touch upon the previous study on adults with the common cold.
