#### WHAT IS SPOC?

SPoC takes prof-to-prof referrals for people who require access to rapid urgent assessments and support by health, social care and wider community teams.

An experienced SPoC Lead will use their advanced decisionmaking skills to navigate the person to the most appropriate teams to develop a plan. Plans will be developed within 2-4 hours and communicated back to the referring professional in a timely manner.

### **SPOC ACCESS CRITERIA**



- Resident of West Lothian
- Adult 18+
- Patient/ Guardian/ Carer consent obtained

#### **SPOC EXCLUSION** CRITERIA



- Acute chest pain
- Acute stroke
- Surgical problems
- Shock
- Suspected fracture
- Low GCS <9 (does not apply for end of</li> life/palliative care)
- Acute mental health issues (with the exception of cognitive impairment due to dementia)



H@H can take referrals for people who are acutely unwell and who require medical or nursing intervention to prevent a hospital admission. If a H@H referral is needed, please contact the team via the usual pathways call 01506 524149.
